

Senior School at Koonung Secondary College

The Senior School at Koonung Secondary College cares for the academic progress and wellbeing of all students in Years 10, 11 and 12. Once students enter the Senior School, their academic load focuses on the core subjects of English and Maths, while allowing students to choose a range of elective subjects that teach the knowledge and skills necessary for a successful VCE program. The student experience at Koonung Secondary College is designed to be a holistic experience where academic rigour is coupled with the ability to undertake a number of extra-curricular activities across sport, leadership, community development, and the creative arts.
